HSCIC publishes this information every three months on behalf of the Office for Life Sciences.

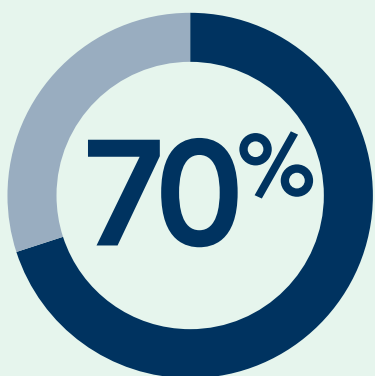


3 groups of medicines used to treat major conditions:

For the 12 months from October 2014 to September 2015 (compared to previous 12 months):

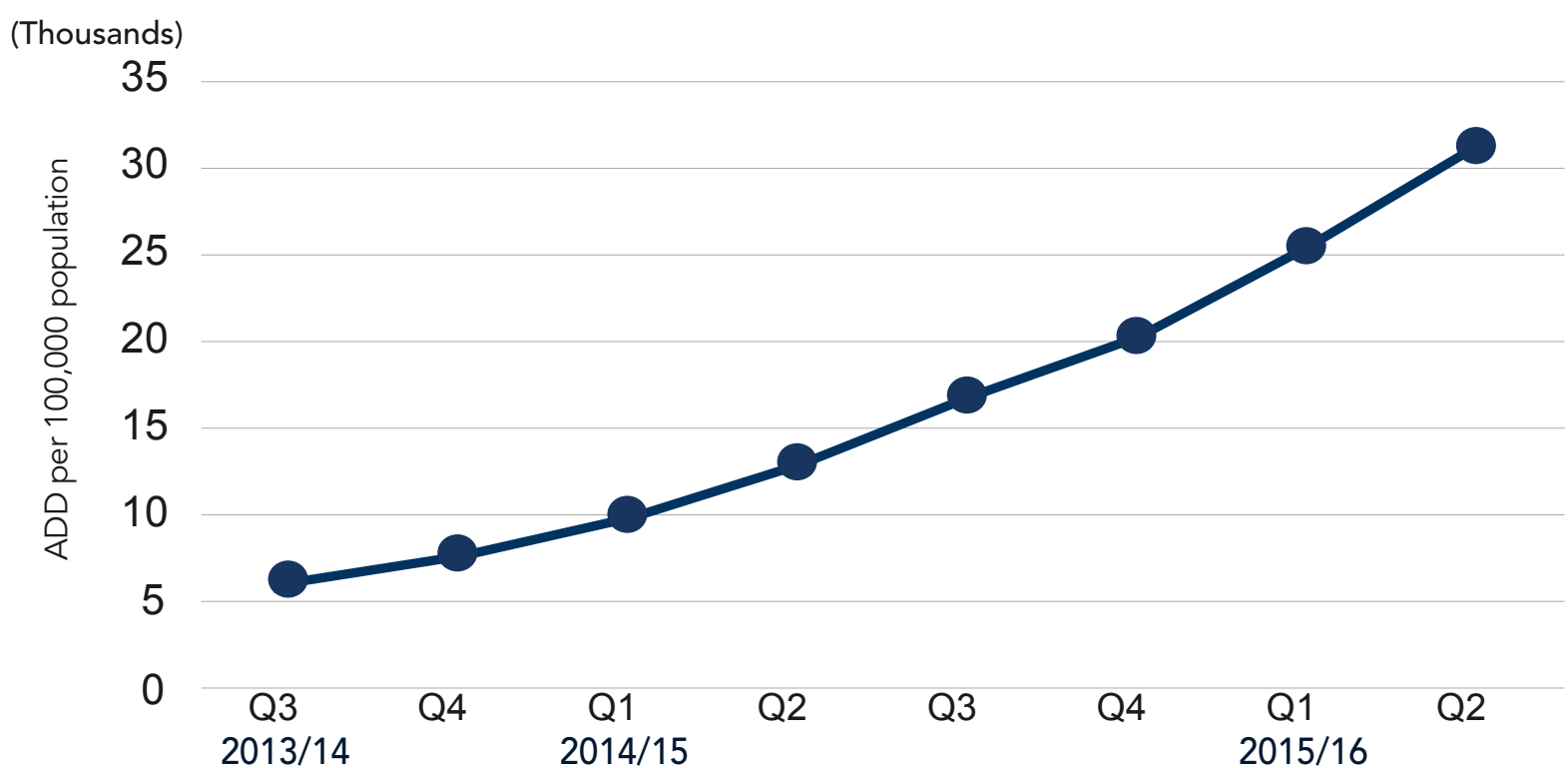


medicines prescribed more*
